KUALA LUMPUR: A woman entrepreneur suffered losses of RM310,000 after being contacted by a “bank officer”. Kuala Lumpur Commercial Crime Investigation Department (CCID) chief Assistant Commissioner Mohd Mahidisham Ishak said the woman, 55, was contacted by a man impersonating a bank officer who claimed that her credit card had been used to make large transactions.
