Civil servant loses RM6,000 to Macau scam

JEMPOL: A civil servant, 23, lost RM6,000 to a Macau scam on Thursday. Jempol police chief Superintendent Hoo Chang Hook yesterday said the victim received a call from a man who introduced himself as an employee of the Cyberjaya Inland Revenue Board. He said the victim was informed that he had tax arrears amounting to RM58,500.82, which needed to be cleared before 4pm on the same day. The victim said he did not have any debt or tax arrears. The suspect said the victim's MyKad had been registered with a company in Kota Baru. The suspect asked for the victim's bank details and transaction authorisation code." Hoo said the victim realised he had been cheated after the suspect asked him to change his name and password, and upon checking online later, found that RM6,000 had been transferred out.
