Posing as insurance officers latest scam tactic

KOTA BARU: Macau scam syndicates have changed their modus operandi from posing as Inland Revenue Board officers to insurance officers to deceive the public. State police chief Datuk Shafien Mamat said police had recorded at least three such cases. "However, they are still using the same tactics to deceive their victims and sometimes pretending to be police officers to get the confidence of victims," he said. Shafien said the syndicates would target high earners, especially government servants. He advised the public to refer to the authorities if they received such calls. The latest Macau scam case involved a female civil servant, in her 50s, who lost RM395,000 to scammers who posed as insurance and police officers.
