Housewife scammed of RM87,000

SIBU: A housewife in a fishing village in Igan, Mukah Division near here, lost more than RM87,000 to a Macau scam syndicate. Sibu district acting police chief Superintendent Dr Collin Babat said the woman, in her 50s, lodged a report with the Sibu police station on Monday. He said the victim received a phone call from a woman called Mastura on Nov 30 last year and who claimed that the housewife's name had been used in insurance claims amounting to RM76,800 within three months. Collin said the victim was then told to open an account at a bank in Sibu, hand over her bank account and Tabung Haji account information and make five cash transactions totalling RM61,000 from Dec 13 to Jan 4. **Bernama**
