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## **Woman loses RM78,000 to Macau scam**

**KUANTAN:** A nursery assistant lost RM78,000 of her savings to a Macau scam syndicate. Pahang Commercial Crime Investigation Department chief Superintendent Mohd Wazir Mohd Yusof said in a press statement yesterday that it started when the 56-year-old woman received a call purportedly from the police informing her that her car had been stolen. "An 'Inspector Mazlan' claimed the victim was also involved in a money laundering case." He added that a woman contacted the victim later and said she could help clear her name. She was asked to activate her Internet banking account and reveal her ATM card number. "She was asked to go the Employees Provident Fund office here to transfer her savings to her bank account, totalling RM78,000."
