## **MCMC warns of fraud bid using Jaringan Prihatin info**

**CYBERJAYA:** The Malaysian Communications and Multimedia Commission (MCMC) revealed that there have been attempts to deceive the public through phone calls or short message service by parties posing as representatives of a service provider offering RM300 through the Jaringan Prihatin programme. MCMC said the people contacted would be asked to provide personal information such as their identity card number, ATM card number and the three digit-card verification number on the back of the ATM card to the unknown party. The commission said the public could channel information and lodge complaints on scams to the police via 03-26101559 or 03-26101599. The lines are open daily from 8am to 8pm.
